Residual Sales of Unallocated Units of Bundled Capacity and Tanker Slot

National Grid LNG Storage has today announced that, following Stage Two of its 2012 Annual Storage Invitation, 5,965,436 kWh (203,549 therms) of capacity remains unallocated at Avonmouth.

This capacity can be purchased on a first come first served basis at a price of 0.6313 p/kWh (18.50 p/therm) per bundled unit. This price is the weighted average of the top 50% of accepted bids over the two stages of the auction at Avonmouth plus 0.1 pence per unit of bundled capacity as set out in paragraph 8.2 of the 2012 Annual Storage Invitation.

National Grid LNG Storage also confirms that one tanker slot remains unallocated at Avonmouth. This slot can be purchased on a first come first served basis at a price of $\pounds 8,881.55$ per annum.
